Civil Engineering Law and Contract Management (NEC™)

Quigg Golden is again running the prestigious ICE Law and Contract Management course for the Republic of Ireland Region of the ICE. The course is a must for anyone involved in the legal or construction industry working with the standard forms of construction contract.

Course Dates

- There will also be three revision seminars, focussing on exam preparation and practice, as well as giving a chance to recap over the previous months, held in May 2018.
